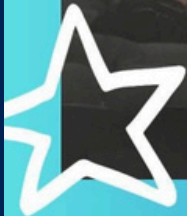

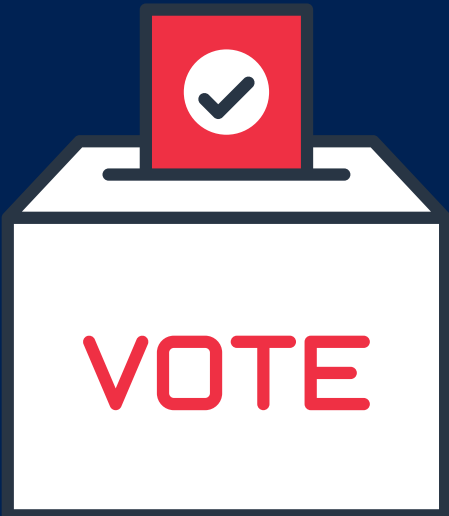


We celebrate our School Psychologist Team every day, and especially during the week of November 11-15th for National School Psychology Week. Thank you for all that you do for our students!

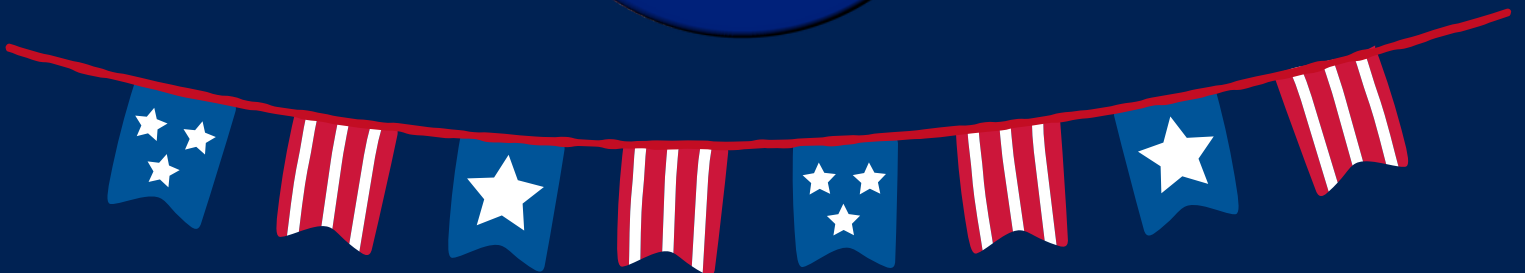
